Indication

BOTOX[®] is a prescription medicine that is injected to prevent headaches in adults with chronic migraine who have 15 or more days each month with headache lasting 4 or more hours each day in people 18 years or older.

It is not known whether BOTOX[®] is safe or effective to prevent headaches in patients with migraine who have 14 or fewer headache days each month (episodic migraine).

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

BOTOX[®] may cause serious side effects that can be life threatening. Get medical help right away if you have any of these problems any time (hours to weeks) after injection of BOTOX[®]:

- **Problems swallowing, speaking, or breathing**, due to weakening of associated muscles, can be severe and result in loss of life. You are at highest risk if these problems are pre-existing before injection. Swallowing problems may last for several months.

- **Spread of toxin effects.** The effect of botulinum toxin may affect areas away from the injection site and cause serious symptoms including: loss of strength and all-over muscle weakness, double vision, blurred vision and drooping eyelids, hoarseness or change or loss of voice, trouble saying words clearly, loss of bladder control, trouble breathing, trouble swallowing.

There has not been a confirmed serious case of spread of toxin effect away from the injection site when BOTOX[®] has been used at the recommended dose to treat chronic migraine.

BOTOX[®] may cause loss of strength or general muscle weakness, vision problems, or dizziness within hours to weeks of taking BOTOX[®]. **If this happens, do not drive a car, operate machinery, or do other dangerous activities.**

You may be eligible for the
BOTOX® Savings Program if you:

- Are 18 years or older
- Have commercial insurance (can't be enrolled in or eligible for Medicare, Medicaid, or any state/federal insurance program)
- Received BOTOX® treatment for an approved use (like Chronic Migraine)

Program Terms, Conditions, and Eligibility Criteria: **1.** This offer is good for use only with a valid prescription for BOTOX® (onabotulinumtoxinA). **2.** Based on insurance coverage, Chronic Migraine patients can receive up to \$700 off per treatment for up to 5 treatments in 2018. All treatments must be received during 2018. Maximum savings limit of \$3500 per year for people with Chronic Migraine applies; patient out-of-pocket expense may vary. **3.** This offer is not valid for use by patients enrolled in Medicare, Medicaid, or other federal or state programs (including any state pharmaceutical assistance programs), or private indemnity or HMO insurance plans that reimburse you for the entire cost of your prescription drugs. Patients may not use this offer if they are Medicare-eligible and enrolled in an employer-sponsored health plan or prescription drug benefit program for retirees. This offer is not valid for cash-paying patients. **4.** This offer is valid for up to 5 treatments per year. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION (continued)

Do not receive BOTOX® if you: are allergic to any of its ingredients (see Medication Guide for ingredients); had an allergic reaction to any other botulinum toxin product such as *Myobloc*® (rimabotulinumtoxinB), *Dysport*® (abobotulinumtoxinA), or *Xeomin*® (incobotulinumtoxinA); have a skin infection at the planned injection site.

The dose of BOTOX® is not the same as, or comparable to, another botulinum toxin product.

Serious and/or immediate allergic reactions have been reported, including itching, rash, red itchy welts, wheezing, asthma symptoms, or dizziness or feeling faint. Get medical help right away if you experience symptoms; further injection of BOTOX® should be discontinued.

HOW THE BOTOX® SAVINGS PROGRAM WORKS FOR THOSE WHO ARE ELIGIBLE

INITIAL PAYMENT

You pay a certain amount out of pocket at the **time of treatment**, then file a claim for reimbursement

RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT

After your claim is approved, you can choose to have your **reimbursement check** sent to you or the doctor that provided treatment[§]

TOTAL PAYMENT

Depending on your insurance coverage, you may end up paying **\$0** for treatment

How to sign up and submit a claim

1. Check eligibility at BOTOXSavingsProgram.com.
2. If you're eligible, fill out forms online.
3. Receive BOTOX® treatment for an approved therapeutic use (like Chronic Migraine).
4. Submit a claim online through the program website.



Checking eligibility, signing up, and saving is easy.

Provider (SPP) receipt. (If the BOTOX® prescription was filled by a Specialty Pharmacy Provider, both EOB and SPP details must be provided.) All claims must be submitted within 90 days of the date of EOB receipt. You may be required to provide a copy of your EOB or SPP receipt for your claim to be approved. **7.** A BOTOX® Savings Program check may be sent either directly to you or to your selected healthcare provider who provided treatment. For payment to be made directly to your healthcare provider, you must authorize an assignment of benefit during each claim submission. You are not obligated to assign your BOTOX® Savings Program benefit to your healthcare provider to participate in the program. **8.** Allergan reserves the right to rescind, revoke, or amend this offer without notice. **9.** Offer good only in the USA, including Puerto Rico, at participating retail locations. **10.** Void where prohibited by law, taxed, or restricted. **11.** This offer is not health insurance. **12. By participating in the BOTOX® Savings Program, you acknowledge that you are an eligible patient and that you understand and agree to comply with the terms and conditions of this offer.**

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION (continued)

Tell your doctor about all your muscle or nerve conditions such as ALS or Lou Gehrig's disease, myasthenia gravis, or Lambert-Eaton syndrome, as you may be at increased risk of serious side effects including difficulty swallowing and difficulty breathing from typical doses of BOTOX®.

Tell your doctor about all your medical conditions, including if you: have or have had bleeding problems; have plans to have surgery; had surgery

on your face; weakness of forehead muscles; trouble raising your eyebrows; drooping eyelids; any other abnormal facial change; are pregnant or plan to become pregnant (it is not known if BOTOX® can harm your unborn baby); are breastfeeding or plan to (it is not known if BOTOX® passes into breast milk).

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IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION (continued)

Tell your doctor about all the medicines you take, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements. Using BOTOX[®] with certain medicines may cause serious side effects. **Do not start any new medicines until you have told your doctor that you received BOTOX[®] in the past.**

Tell your doctor if you received any other botulinum toxin product in the last 4 months; have received injections of botulinum toxin such as *Myobloc*[®], *Dysport*[®], or *Xeomin*[®] in the past (tell your doctor exactly which product you received); have recently received an antibiotic injection; take muscle relaxants; take allergy

or cold medicines; take sleep medicine; take aspirin-like products or blood thinners.

Other side effects of BOTOX[®] include: dry mouth, discomfort or pain at injection site, tiredness, headache, neck pain, eye problems: double vision, blurred vision, decreased eyesight, drooping eyelids, swelling of eyelids, dry eyes; and drooping eyebrows.
